

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE POST OF SOCIAL NETWORKING COORDINATOR

OVERVIEW

The Social Networking Coordinators are responsible for maintaining and developing the Society's social media presence.

POSITION TYPE

These are non-salaried volunteer positions appointed by the Committee. The Social Networking Coordinators are elected biannually by the Committee at the first meeting following the AGM. The postholders do not need to be members of the Committee.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be willing to attend Committee meetings of the Society
- Must be adept with the use of email, the internet and social media networks
- Must demonstrate tact and diplomacy, with the ability to listen and engage effectively
- Must have strong networking capabilities that can be used for the benefit of the Society
- Must have the ability to foster and promote a collaborative team environment
- Must have a good working knowledge of the various social media channels
- Should be familiar with the major research processes in surname studies
- Should have the ability to commit time to conduct the role well, including travel and attending events out of office hours
- Should have excellent communication skills (both verbal and written)

SPECIFIC TASKS

Perform the following duties in furtherance of the Society's goals, including but not limited to:

- Coordinate presence on social networking sites including the Society's blog, Facebook, Twitter and other similar community sites, posting on external relevant blogs and seeding content into social applications as appropriate
- Develop an effective social media strategy
- Become an advocate of the Society in social media spaces, engaging in dialogues and answering questions where appropriate
- Regularly feedback insights gained from social media monitoring to the Committee, to help them evolve their strategies in a timely fashion
- Monitor developments in social media tools, trends and applications
- Liaise with the Webmaster to ensure the Society's social media tools are kept up to date

TIME COMMITMENT

The Social Networking Coordinator's time commitment is, at a minimum, approximately five to ten hours per week.
